What We Do

Matthew 25 is inspired by the gospel to provide free health and dental services to the uninsured, low-income residents of Northeast Indiana and Northwest Ohio. We serve over 115 patients daily. That could not be done without the hundreds of volunteers who give their time, talents, and commitment to Matthew 25. Volunteers are the very heart of Matthew 25 and we could not provide care for our patients without them.

Volunteer Opportunities

Volunteers serve in all aspects of the clinic. We have positions for professional and lay volunteers. Opportunities include, but not limited to: physician, nurse, dentist, dental hygienists, pharmacists, medication room tech, pharmaceutical processor, reception and data entry. We will work together to find the right fit for you.

How to become a volunteer...

1. Fill out a volunteer application-We highly recommend you fill out the electronic application on website. However you may stop by the clinic for a paper application as well.
2. Contact the volunteer coordinator to schedule a time for the 'New Volunteer Orientation'.
3. After attending orientation, the volunteer coordinator will set up a training date in the department of your interest
4. Once you have received some training, you and the coordinator of the department you are in will set up a schedule for you to volunteer.

Please contact the contact the volunteer coordinator **first**, if you are interested in completing required hours at Matthew 25. You must have permission from the specific department you wish to work in before you can become a volunteer and begin your service hours.

Frequently Asked Questions

Am I required to have an active medical/dental or other professional license?

If you are volunteering as a physician, dentist, nurse, hygienist, etc., you need a current license for Indiana. If you do not, we have multiple volunteer opportunities that require no license or professional training.

How much time is required to volunteer?

We ask that you commit 3-4 hours every week or every other week.

Can volunteers request shifts/thier own schedule?

Yes. You can select times and days you are available on your application. Once volunteering you work with the department you are in to create a schedule that works best for you.

How old do I need to be to volunteer?

Volunteers need to be 18 years or older.

Can I volunteer and be a patient?

No. You must be either a volunteer or a patient , you cannot be both.
